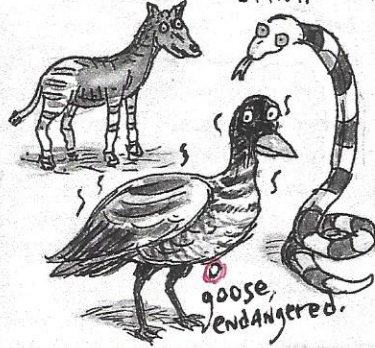

ALAN sang an ADAGIO^{slow} ARIA^{slow} from AIDA^{slow}, while I played an OBOE^{slow}.

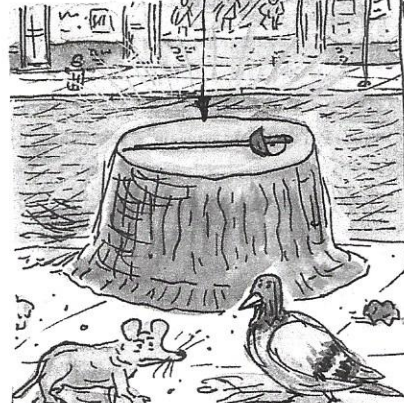


UMA Thurman showed up in a BOA^{slow}, which IRED^{slow} us. She was reading OMOO^{slow}.

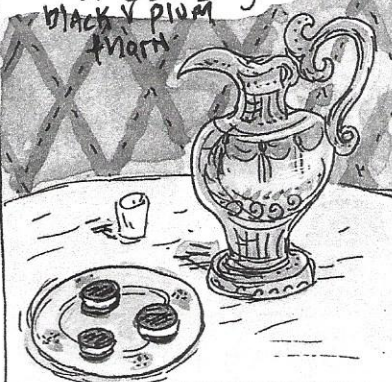

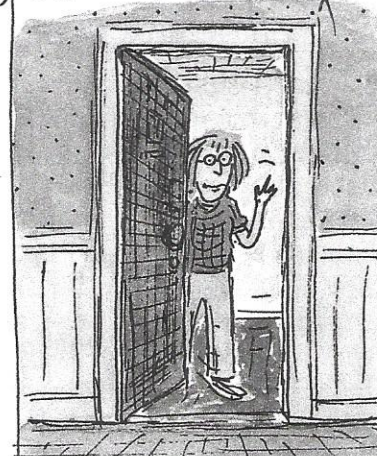
ALAS, I'd left my ÉPÉE^{fencing blade} on a WEE MESA^{table-like mtn. sp.} in SOHO, NYC.
